Ken Algar is leading a visit to this very interesting and modern museum which features items collected over the years that relate to the history of packaging and products. It is just 2 minutes from Ladbroke Grove underground station.

You will see things that you will remember from yesteryear such as copies of early comics, toys, televisions and radios and things as basic as Dreft soap flakes.

You'll notice how some well-known products have remained in the same style of packaging for many years.

Most of the items are displayed in the Time Tunnel, a serpentine journey through cabinet after cabinet of memorabilia. There are also separate displays of interest which change from time to time.

The museum is on the ground floor and step free. There is an excellent cafe and, outside, a subtropical garden, ideal on a sunny day.
