Titsey Place is an English country house near Oxted. It is set in the stunning landscape of the North Downs. It was successively the seat of the Gresham and Leveson-Gower families and is now preserved by a charitable trust for the nation.

The main building dates from 1775 and there are areas that go back as far as the Tudors. Enjoy family portraits and other paintings including four Canaletto pictures of Venice, beautiful collections of porcelain and furniture. The guided tour of the house lasts approx. 1 hour plus a visit of the gardens which reflects the grandeur of the house.

We will assemble at **2.15 pm for the tours to begin at 2.30 pm**. One group will start with the house tour which will take approximately an hour, while another group will take a self-guided tour of the gardens. At 3.30pm the groups will swap. **The cost for the tour of the house and gardens is £10 per person.**

There are tearooms serving a variety of light lunches, cakes, cream tea or a full afternoon tea. **At 1pm an optional savoury buffet** will be available for U3a members in the tea rooms prior to the tour of the house and garden.. **The cost for this buffet is £15 per person.**

You are welcome to come just for the tour of the house and gardens or just the buffet.

Travel is by car and there is ample parking.
